



Call for Proposals

School Science and Mathematics Special Issue P-12 Engineering Education

The *School Science and Mathematics* editorial staff requests the submission of manuscripts for an upcoming special issue on P-12 engineering education. With the increased focused on engineering initiatives in P-12, a better understanding of efforts that are being made to increase student interest and persistence toward engineering is needed. In particular, we are seeking manuscripts on P-12 Engineering Education in the following areas:

- Studies of P-12 teachers and/or schools/districts implementing engineering curriculum/programs
- Integration of engineer career awareness into P-12 curriculum
- Studies of P-12 pre-engineering programs (formal and informal) – growing the engineering pipeline
- Current review of instruments being used to assess engineering education initiatives or related beliefs and attitudes
- Engineering education professional development for preservice and in-service teachers
- Examination of or framework for examining P-12 Engineering focused curriculum

All manuscripts must meet the length and format guidelines for the journal (see the information at <http://www.ssmj.tamu.edu>). A group of Reviewers and Associate Editors will be identified to review the manuscripts.

A total of five manuscripts will be selected for publication in the P-12 Engineering Education Special Issue to be published in May 2018.

Manuscripts need to be submitted by December 1, 2017 through the Scholar One website (<http://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/ssm>). Please indicate in your cover letter that your manuscript is to be considered for the P-12 Engineering Education special issue.
